Anatomy.TV is a library database that features interactive 3D models of the human body as well as quizzes, dissection images, slides, videos, and MRI images.

GETTING THERE

Start at GCC Library's home page at [lib.gccaz.edu](#). Select the **Library Databases** link on the left side of the search box.

Select **Anatomy.TV**. If you're not using a campus computer, you'll be asked to enter your MEID and password.

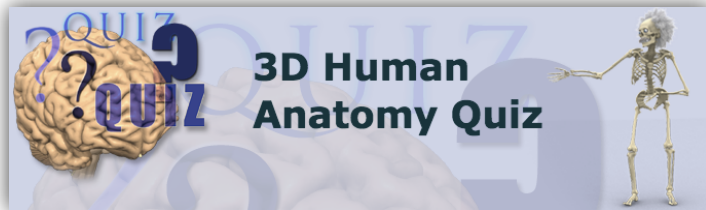
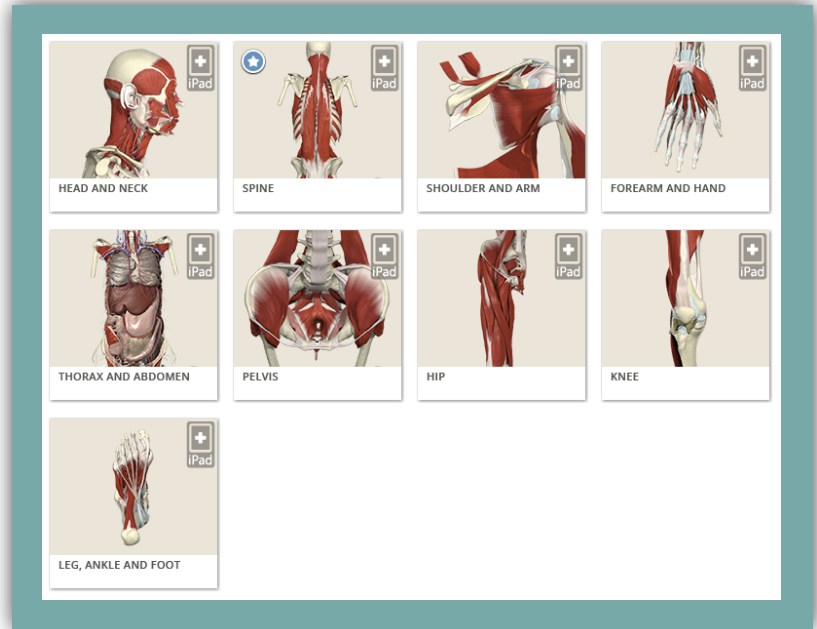

YOU'RE AT THE CONTROLS

Select **3D Atlas** from the menu on the left. Select the area of the body that you want to explore.

Use the controls at the bottom of the pop-up window to transition through anatomical layers and to rotate, zoom, and flip the image. The tool bar on the left includes 3D and MRI views, slides, movies, animations, clinical text, etc.

If you want to learn more about the features, explore the **Help and About** window on the right side.



Tip: If you can't view images in the window on the lower left, check the pop-ups setting on your browser.
