Searching the GCC Library Catalog

1. Start at the GCC Library's home page at lib.gccaz.edu/lmc (or use a shortcut: is.gd/gcclib).

2. Click Find Books.



3. Click on **Signature Collections**.



4. Click Literacy.



5. Type a keyword, a book title, or an author's name in the box and press **Search**.



6. Look over your search results. Can you find a book that you would like to read? Write down the book's **location**, which is a code that will help you find the book on the shelf.
