Searching the GCC Library Catalog

- 1. Start at the GCC Library's home page at lib.gccaz.edu/lmc.
- 2. Click Find Books.



3. Click **Signature Collections**.



4. Click **Literacy**.



5. Enter a **keyword**, a **book title**, or an **author's name** in the box and press **Search**.



6. Look at your search results. Do you see a book that you would like to read? Write down the book's **location**, which will help you find the book on the shelf.




