News You Can Use

As original documents from the time period you're studying, newspapers are valuable primary sources. Library databases offer both current and historical papers.

Explore these seven news databases

Arizona Republic

Want to include the local angle on your research topic? You'll find articles from 1999 to the present.

U.S. Major Dailies

Find articles from the Chicago Tribune, Los Angeles Times, New York Times, Wall St. Journal, and Washington digital archive from Post.

Ethnic NewsWatch

Includes newspapers, magazines & journals of the ethnic, minority & native press. Articles in Spanish are included.

Gale NewsVault

Includes U.S. newspapers from 1800-1899 and the Times (London) 1785-2011.

Historical Index to the **New York Times**

The U.S. "newspaper of record," the New York Times, has chronicled "all the news that's fit to print" since 1851. Find full-text articles from 1851 through 2015. For recent issues of the New York Times, search the ProQuest Newspaper Multi-Search database.

Infotrac Newsstand

Get complete articles from over 2,300 major U.S. national regional, and local newspapers as well as leading international publications. You'll also find are thousands of images and radio and TV broadcasts and transcripts are also provided.


ProQuest Newspaper Multi-Search

How to get there

Finding all the news that's fit to digitize

1. Start at lib.gccaz.edu/lmc, the Library's home page. Click on Library Databases on the left side of the search box.



- 2. Locate the **News** category on the next page.
- 3. Search for articles about your topic in one or more of these seven recommended databases. Use the database's filters to limit your search results by publication date, location, etc. You'll also find tools that will help you cite, email, and save articles of interest.
