



Library Databases for **GCC Religion Students**

Explore these recommended databases

Academic Search Complete — Full-text articles from over 9000 full-text journals, magazines, and newspapers! This database is useful when searching for peer-reviewed articles.

Credo Reference — Tap into a collection of over 900 subject encyclopedias and specialized dictionaries. *Tip: Look for in-depth articles by checking the word count provided in your search results.*

Daily Life through History — Investigate ordinary life, including religious practices, through time and across the globe.

Gale Reference - Religion provides articles from a collection of previously published subject-specialized encyclopedias.

JSTOR — Find scholarly journals and books with in-depth coverage.

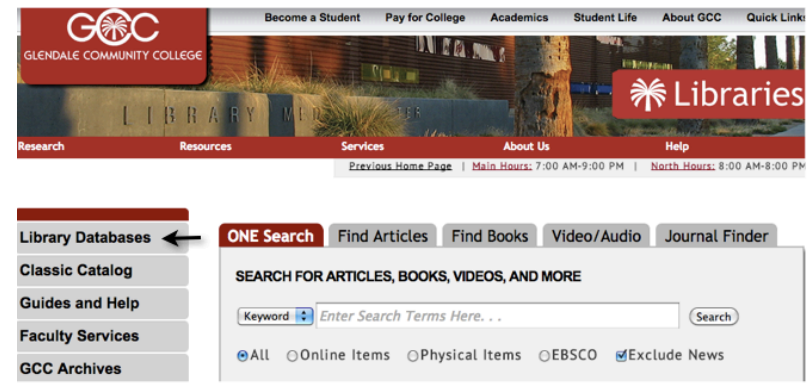
Religion & Philosophy Collection — This source has extensive coverage of topics related to world religions.

World Folklore & Folklife — Explore religion, beliefs, rituals, and ceremonies from cultures around the world.

Locating the databases

Start at the Library's home page at lib.gccaz.edu/lmc.

Click the **Library Databases** link located on the left side of the page.
